

Privacy policy

How 1 Fútbol Sport Science handles personal information. Written to be understood, not to be impressive.

1 Fútbol Sport Science provides performance analysis to football clubs. To do that we hold information about players. This policy explains what we hold, why, and what you can do about it. It follows the Australian Privacy Principles under the Privacy Act 1988.

1 · What we collect and hold

- **Identity and profile:** name, date of birth, squad number, position, height, weight, photo.
- **Performance:** GPS from training and matches — distance, speed, sprints, accelerations.
- **Wellbeing:** rating of perceived exertion after sessions, and training load calculated from it.
- **Physical testing:** jump, sprint, strength, and left-to-right differences.
- **Health:** injury status, availability, and notes from medical and coaching staff.
- **Account:** for staff and players who log in — name, email, role, and club.

Injury, availability and testing results are **health information**, which the Privacy Act treats as sensitive. We only collect it with the player's written consent.

2 · How we collect it

- **From the club**, which supplies the squad list and the files from its GPS units.
- **From the player**, who enters his own RPE after a session.
- **From staff**, who record testing results and notes.

We do not collect anything automatically from a player's phone beyond what he types in.

3 · How we hold it

Information is stored in **Sydney, Australia**, on servers run by our hosting provider. Access is controlled by the database itself, not by what a screen chooses to show: a person who is not permitted to see a record cannot retrieve it at all. Each club's information is separated from every other club's.

We keep information while a club is a customer, and for the retention period agreed with that club. When it is no longer needed we delete it or strip the identifying details.

4 · Why we collect, hold, use and disclose it

- To plan and monitor training, and to reduce injury risk.
- To produce reports for the club's coaching and medical staff.
- To show a player his own numbers.
- To support and improve the service.

We do not sell it, we do not share it between clubs, and we do not use it for advertising.

5 · How to see your information or have it corrected

Write to us at _____. We will give you a copy of what we hold about you, normally within 30 days and at no cost. If something is wrong, tell us and we will fix it. If we decide not to, we will explain why in writing.

6 · How to complain

Write to us first, at the same address. We will respond within 30 days. If you are not satisfied, you can complain to the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner — oaic.gov.au, or 1300 363 992. Complaining costs nothing.

7 · Overseas disclosure

We do not send personal information overseas. It is stored in Australia and accessed from Australia. If that ever changes we will say so here and tell the clubs affected before it happens.

If something goes wrong

If information is lost or accessed by someone who should not have it, and that is likely to cause serious harm, we will tell the people affected and the Information Commissioner, as the Notifiable Data Breaches scheme requires.
